Pack Meetings

Pack meetings are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month. This is when awards are handed out and a time when the entire pack meets together.

Monthly Pack Committee Meeting:

The Pack holds a monthly Pack Committee meeting which occurs on the 2nd Tuesday of the month from 6:00-7:00 PM. This is a time for the Pack Committee to meet and plan upcoming Pack related events and general Pack administrative task. All are welcome!

ANNUAL DUES AND FEES

Our annual Pack Dues are \$125.00 that is collected in November and paid directly to the Pack.

There is a separate Scouting America annual fee due per Scout and Adult Leaders which is paid by the individual (or by the parents for youth Scouts).

This fee per Scout is \$85.00 and per Adult Leader \$65.00. This is paid directly through Scouting America.

Pack 444- Frequently Asked Questions

What is the time commitment from your youth?

Approximately 4-6 hours per month – and some requirements will be completed at home.

How often do we meet?

Pack meetings (all dens combined) are generally held on the first Tuesday. Meetings are held at First Presbyterian Church of Littleton from 7:00-8:00 PM. Dens meetings (divided by grade level K – 5th) are held approximately 3 times per month during the school year in order to meet all requirements for rank. There may be occasional but infrequent Pack or Den activity opportunities on a weekend.

What are the Cub Scout Ranks?

Ranks are divided by school year grade levels. Lions-Kindergarten, Tigers- 1st Grade, Wolf- 2nd Grade, Bear- 3rd grade, webeles-4th grade, Arrow of Lights- 5th grade. Though Den's are split by grade level you are not required to start in Kindergarten. Scouts can join at anytime from Kindergarten (or 5 years old) through 5th Grade.

What do parents do?

Scouting is designed to be family friendly. Parents are welcomed and encouraged to stay for all pack and den activities. Siblings are always welcome. Our pack relies on parent involvement to keep things running smoothly. Various opportunities to be involved will be communicated on an as needed basis throughout the year. At least one parent/guardian must attend all activities for Lions (kindergarten) through Bears (3rd grade).

How much does Cub Scouts cost?

Fall Popcorn sales are typically our only fundraiser for the year. The money raised typically covers all of our necessary expenses except for annual dues when ALL the Scouts sell popcorn. Current yearly Pack dues are \$125 which includes: a pack t-shirt (for new Scouts/replacement for returning Scouts), Pack supplies/consumables, PWD Car Kit, and various other Pack related expenses.

There is a national Scouting America fee that is paid annually by the individual family of the Scout. The per Scout fee is \$85.00 and paid directly to Scouting America. Our Pack receives no portion of this fee. We do expect that all Scouts will participate in fundraising and those who don't will have an additional fee as applicable. We do have Scholarships available whenever families may need them.

What about a uniform?

What is the religious component of Cub Scouts?

Faith is one of the 12 core values in cub scouting. There are religious requirements for each rank, but they are done at home according to the beliefs of each individual family. Even though our pack meets at a Presbyterian church, the Pack is not religiously affiliated with the church, or any other denomination.

Cub Scout Adventures 2025-2026 Scouting Year

For a Cub Scout to earn each rank they are required to complete the six required Adventures and two elective Adventures throughout their year of Scouting.

Required Adventures reflect the aims and focus areas of what Scouting is all about.

These adventures are worked on during the weekly Den meetings within individual Den's as each Rank has different requirements to achieve specific adventure.

The Bobcat is the first Adventure that each Scout must complete each year followed by the other 5 required adventures.

Each Den has the following adventure category requirements:

- Character & Leadership
- Outdoors
- Personal Fitness
- Citizenship
- Personal Safety
- Family/Reverence

Below outlines the adventures by Rank for this Scouting Year:

The Bobcat Adventure is designed to be the first required Adventure.

Each badge of rank is earned by completing six required and two elective Adventures.

The six required Adventures are focused on the aims and focus areas of the BSA.

Class "A" Uniform – What to buy

All New Scouts will need to buy the following items:

Returning Scouts may need to purchase new items based on new rank Scouting Year.

Cub Scout Shirt (Blue for all Ranks except Lions and AOL's)

Lion and AOL Scouts- Please review specific section for additional information prior to ordering



Navy Blue Bottoms

Official Cub Scout Bottoms are suggested however they are not required. Scouts may wear bottoms that are solid Navy Blue either pants, shorts or skort.

Cub Scout Socks (Navy blue with yellow leg tops)

Cub Scout Hat (Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear or Webelos)

Lion (Kindergarten) Scout Only

For our youngest Scouts the Lion Uniform for the first year is slightly different than other ranks. If you wish to purchase your Lion Scout a official Scout Uniform as outlined above that is completely acceptable however the official Scouting America Cub Scout uniform does not require the Navy Blue Uniform Top or Socks. Instead the Lion's wear the official Lion T-shirt.

The Lion Cub Scout uniform has the following parts:

- 1.Shirt: The official Lion t-shirt.
- 2.Belt: Official navy-blue web belt with metal buckle.
- 3.Cap: Official navy-blue Lion cap.
- 4.Neckerchief: Lion neckerchief.
- 5.Neckerchief Slide: Lion neckerchief slide or Pack 444 provided Slide



Official uniform pants, shorts, or skorts, and Cub Scout socks are optional, however we suggest all Lion Scouts wear some sort of Navy Blue Bottoms.

There is no uniform inspection for Lions.

Arrow of Light (AOL) Scout Only

As this is the final year for our oldest Scouts this is a exciting time as they begin to transition into the Troop during this Scouting year.

Therefore AOL's are required to have the following for their uniforms.

1. Official Tan Uniform Top
2. Green Bottoms (Shorts, Long Pants, Skorts, Roll Up Pants, etc)
3. Official Green Web Belt with Scouting American buckle.
4. Official Green Socks (three lengths available)
5. Adventures Colors: The Adventure Colors are worn on the right sleeve to display the Arrow of Light Adventure Pins that have been earned.
6. Loops: Official Cub Scouts blue loops are worn on the shoulders of the shirt.



The following are optional:

- 1.Hat: Optional – Arrow of Light Scouts may wear any official Scouting America hat.
- 2.Neckerchief: Optional – Arrow of Light Scouts may wear any official Scouting America neckerchief.
- 3.If wearing Neckerchief → Official Scouting America slide with Scouting America emblem.

Someone at the Scout Shop will be available to help you locate all necessary options. The Scout Shop also offers sewing services for patches and emblems at a cost of \$4.00 per patch.

Once you are at the Scout Shop webpage there is a Shop by Scout Option which will help guide you through building your uniform and ensuring you have all the correct patches and emblems however please refer to the above guide prior to checking out to ensure you have all necessary items. There is costs for shipping and handling. Most orders placed online will ship within 4 business days from the date the order is received. Most orders are shipped by Ground and orders are received generally 10 business days AFTER ship date. Planning for around 15 days from the time you place your order to the time you receive your order is a good general rule of thumb.


